How to apply

If you are considering applying to MSc “Geoenvironmental Resources & Risks”, please read carefully the following application process guidelines.

Check the entry requirements

- Check that you meet the entry requirements for the programme.
- If your education has not been conducted in English, you will be expected to demonstrate evidence of an adequate level of English proficiency.
- If you have additional questions you can contact the relevant Admissions Selector in the department.

Check application deadlines

Remember to check application deadlines which for the Academic year 2017 is September 20, 2017

How to submit your application

- You can apply through e-mail, ordinary mail or to submit your application personally.
- Applications must be supported by:
 1. two references from people who are able to comment on your suitability for the programme for which you are applying;
 2. transcripts for all qualifications that are relevant to your application;
 3. English language certificate (if appropriate);
 4. personal statement

In your application, you will be asked for your academic and employment record, in addition to references and a personal statement.

From your personal statement, we would like to learn:

1. why you want to study Geoenvironmental Resources & Risks at graduate level
2. how your academic background meets the demands of this challenging programme
3. any other experiences that make you suitable for this programme
4. how would you use the M.Sc degree from this programme for your professional carrier

Together with essential academic requirements, the personal statement is your opportunity to elaborate on your reasons for applying to this programme and how your interests match with what the programme will deliver.
